Breaking news: Italian authorities urged to seize £500m superyacht as Putin's critics say he is the real owner — Daily Mail

Allies of Alexei Navalny have told Italian authorities they should seize a 460ft vessel moored off the country's coast because they can prove it belongs to the Russian leader. A probe by the Russian opposition leader's anti-corruption unit examined a host of luxury assets in Europe which they claim are the property of Putin and his family. Chief among the alleged assets is the \$700million superyacht, measuring 140-metres in length, complete with luxury features including two helipads. The six-deck yacht 'Scheherezade' contains space that is the equivalent of two apartment blocks, along with a spa and beauty salon.
