The IMF, the European Commission (EC) and the European Central Bank (ECB) stated in September 2012 that Portugal's debt would peak at 124 % of gross domestic product in 2014. The IMF beforehand stated in July 2012 that Portugal's debt would peak at about 118.5 % of GDP in 2013. In September 2013, the Portuguese Government reviewed once more the general public debt of Portugal for 2013 to 127.8 percent, after a peak of 130.9 percent in that month. A member state of the United Nations since 1955, Portugal can also be a founding member of NATO , OECD and EFTA ; it left the final in 1986 to join the European Economic Community, which grew to become the European Union in 1993. On 27 August 2003, Portugal added the anti-discrimination employment legislation on the basis of sexual orientation.

Wearing of headband and chador was one of major symbols of the revolution, along with the resurgence and carrying of different traditional Iranian dresses.
